2024 AWARDS RECIPIENTS

GSSDA Dance Leader “Over & Above” Award

Purpose of the award: The purpose of the “GSSDA Dance Leader “Over & Above” Award” is to honor Dance Leaders who promote square dancing by recognizing those who demonstrate outstanding community involvement and go above and beyond to promote both their club and Square Dancing in general.

GSSDA DANCE LEADER “OVER & ABOVE” AWARD

RANDY RAMSEY



Lakeshore Squares Club nominates Randy Ramsey for the **GSSDA Dance Leader “Over & Above”** award. In 1992 Brandi, Randy’s wife, wanted to take square dance lessons. Randy wasn’t keen on the idea. Brandi said that’s ok, they tell me there will be men there that will dance with me at lessons. Well Randy wasn’t going to have his wife dancing with someone else and so it began. Soon after he learned to square dance, he was interested in trying to call.

Randy began experimenting calling with Tom Roberts, a fellow club member. While at a regular dance at Peachtree Squares in Atlanta, Randy met the club’s caller, Dan Mitchell. Dan Mitchell mentored Randy in calling and they became close friends. Randy became the club caller for the Dude’s n Darlin’s square dance club in Alpharetta and later in Marietta, and for the Classic City Squares in Athens.

Randy has served as the President of the Georgia Caller Association for many years, where he has mentored many of Georgia’s callers over the years.

Randy was selected February 2019 as the caller of the Lakeshore Squares Club in Gainesville. Randy has always said, “**How can I help?**”. Since joining Lakeshore Squares, Randy has taught and graduated many square dance classes alternating between Mainstream and Plus. Led by Randy, the Lakeshore Squares do not stop having lessons, starting a new class the week following graduation of the previous class. This has led to hundreds of new dancers that feed into all of the Northeast Georgia Federation clubs. Lakeshore Squares has a growing group of youth that have taken lessons with Randy and joined the club.

Randy frequently will call for club exhibitions at local nursing homes, libraries, city parades, and festivals sharing our joy of dance and giving back to our community. He also calls for Daddy

Daughter Dances, weddings, Scout events, and elementary school events. He loves working with youth, introducing them to square dancing. This has resulted in the Lakeshore Squares club having the largest number of active youth club members in the state of Georgia.

Randy is a member of the Georgia State Square Dancers Association (GSSDA) board. He serves as a member of the Dance Leader Programming Committee, inviting and programming Dance Leaders at the GSSDA State Convention and Spring Sashay events. He also organizes, and often supplies the sound equipment for the GSSDA events.

Lakeshore Squares Club is fortunate to have Randy Ramsey as our club caller and a member of our club. We think Randy continuously goes above and beyond to support the local and state square dance activities.

GSSDA Community Outreach Award

Purpose: The purpose of the “GSSDA Community Outreach Award” is to encourage Member Clubs to promote square dancing in their area by recognizing and rewarding Member Clubs that demonstrate outstanding community involvement and promotion of both their club and Square Dancing in general.

GSSDA COMMUNITY OUTREACH AWARD Paulding Pioneers Square Dance Club, Dallas Georgia

Paulding Pioneers of Dallas GA was established in 2023. With numerous mainstream lessons, they proudly maintain a steadily growing membership. They have adopted the nickname, “The Fun Club”, provides an excellent platform for injecting new energy into the square dance experience. Their success empowers the club to be an active contributing member of the local community.

The following is a synopsis of accomplishments:

- The club has placed several articles in the Dallas New Era newspaper to educate the public on the benefits of square dancing.
- Published articles in the Paulding Magazine, a monthly publication that is mailed to over 76,000 homes in the surrounding areas and is available online as well.
- Contacted the Paulding County Chamber of Commerce to determine how our organization might benefit. We were invited to participate in their health fair call “Aging with Grace”.
- Sponsored a square dance demonstration at the Paulding Meadows Arts & Crafts Festival at Earl Duncan Park in Dallas GA. This fall festival is in the top 100 festivals in the

country, having 30,000-40,000 visitors every year, and was created as a fundraiser to benefit children and youth programs in the community through multiple non-profits.

- The club danced at Manor Lake Assisted Living and Memory Care.
- The club contacted ten (10) 55+ communities in the Dallas, Powder Springs, Hiram GA area. Six communities responded and agreed to distribute their beginner lessons flyer and additional information about the club.
- Two “pioneer wagons” have been designed and built for use as as beverage and dessert table at dances. These wagons have been used as booths at festivals, fairs, parades, dance demonstrations, and square dance conventions to draw attention to the Club name and square dancing in general.
- To help new students get started, a used square dance clothing sale was held at the halfway dance.
- To strengthen our square dance community, our club members take part in the monthly visitation program to visit other clubs in the area twice a month.
- A club manual called “Publicity For Your Club” was initiated by a club member to maintain current contacts for members and record methods used to reach the public. The purpose of the manual is to make it easier to routinely inform the public about the benefits of square dancing and to announce upcoming lessons as time goes by. The same guide was used to teach an Education Session at the 2024 Georgia State Convention.

GSSDA Georgia Traveler Program



The Purpose of GSSDA's Georgia Traveler Program (GTP) is to recognize square dancers who visit a variety of club dances, festivals and state square dance conventions. Participants in the GTP attend a club dance or festival in all areas of Georgia and experience the wide variety of wonderful callers, cuers and dancers throughout Georgia. They represent GSSDA's finest and meet square dance friends from all over the state. A special dangle is awarded to the participant after they have visited at least 9 separate square dance events (*not including their home club*). Different color dangles are awarded for different levels of involvement in this prestigious group.

If you are interested in joining this elite group of square dancers or simply want more information, please go to the GSSDA website (GSSDA.ORG) and download the descriptive brochure and start visiting. No advance registration is required. You may email the GTP Program Coordinator at President@GSSDA.org for more information.

FAQ for the Georgia Traveler Program

1. Must I have the specific form for reporting my visits?
No, as long as the information is complete, accurate and readable it will be acceptable.
2. Does the GSSDA event where I receive the award count as the last “visit” for the award?
No, the report of your visits must be in at least 3 days before the start of the event at which you plan to receive the award. However, the event at which you receive the award can count as a visit for the next level award.
3. If I cannot attend the GSSDA event to receive my award will the award be mailed to me? or can a friend pick it up for me?
No, you must be present in person to receive your award. If you are unable to attend the GSSDA Event you can pick up your award at the next GSSDA event you attend.
4. I attended a dance at the Hilton Head Ocean Waves Club in Hardeeville, SC. Does this count as a visit?
Yes, the Hilton Head Ocean Waves are a dues paying member of the GSSDA so the visit does count. Clubs just outside the Georgia State line who join and pay dues as a GSSDA Member Club are eligible to count toward the Georgia Traveler awards.
5. I visited and danced with the Buttons and Bows in Woodstock, GA last Friday night but I forgot to get my form signed. Can I count that visit?
If you get the Caller or the Club President to sign your form attesting that you were there on that date, we will accept the documentation. The Georgia Traveler Program operates mostly on the honor system. Square dancers are a trustworthy group, and we pretty much trust the documentation you provide.
6. I am a member of two clubs. Do I list both as my home club?
No, you simply pick one as your home club. It would be unfair to penalize those dancers who are members of multiple clubs. Everyone, even independent dancers, must list one club as their home club.
7. I am an Independent dancer and not a member of any club. What do I do about listing a home club?
Simply choose the club you most often attend and list it as your home club.
8. If I visit a Club that is not a GSSDA Member Club, does it count?
Yes, you are not required to visit only GSSDA Member Clubs. As long as the Club is inside the geographic boundary of Georgia OR is a dues paying GSSDA Member Club. (See FAQ #4)

Program Purpose:

To encourage GSSDA members to visit a variety of club dances, festivals and state or national conventions.

Participant Goal:

To attend a club dance or festival in all areas of Georgia and experience the wide variety of wonderful callers and dancers throughout Georgia. To represent the GSSDA and meet square dance friends from all over the state.

Program Rules: A special dangle will be awarded to the participant after they have visited at least 9 separate square dance events (not including your home club) and have a form signed and returned to GSSDA for verification. Different color dangles will be awarded as follows:

- 9 Clubs Visited - Red Dangle
- 15 Clubs Visited - White Dangle
- 20 Clubs Visited - Blue Dangle
- 25 Clubs Visited - Silver Dangle
- 30 Clubs Visited - Gold Dangle

Multiple visits to a club only count as one visit per year.

Award dangles will be presented at a GSSDA dance or convention event.

Visitations must happen within a rolling 36 month period. The 3 year time period will begin with the first visit listed/counted.

Traveling couples must complete separate forms. Separate award dangles will be presented.


